

Proposed design for Keizer water tower released

A proposed logo design for Keizer's water tower has been submitted to the City of Keizer.

The logo, released Monday evening upon the Statesman Journal's request, is not yet scheduled to go before the Keizer City Council. City manager Chris Eppley said, so far, support for the design is strong.

"We have not accepted it, though everyone seems to think it's an attractive logo," Eppley said, "and there are still discussions occurring. ... I'm not certain when we'll come to resolution on this matter."

Discussion surrounding the design for the 100-foot water tower near Interstate-5 and Keizer Station mall has dragged for almost as long as the tower has been standing. Completed two years ago, design work on the tower began in earnest in late 2007.

When the design could be painted on the tower has not been determined.
